

EP ENERGY– THE KEY STRUCTURES FOR COAL TRADING AND LOGISTICS:

- **UECT**
 - **EŽ CARGO**
 - **EOP HOKA**

- UECT with its fully owned subsidiary UECT Polska is EP ENERGY trading leg for fossil fuel and additives trading, covering the territory of CZ, SLK, PL, HU and neighboring countries
- Newly established in 2008, UECT consolidates purchases of fossil fuels for EP ENERGY plants on both direct sale and agency basis; also UECT directly optimizes purchases of additives for EP ENERGY CHP plants and manages group wide energy side products and waste handling
- On top of fuel supply to EP ENERGY, UECT is the sole sales agent of PG Silesia, an EPH hard coal mine in Poland with a total production of circa 2,5 mln tones of hard coal (planned for 2014)
- UECT is also an official sales agent of KTK (KUZBASS FUEL COMPANY), one of major Russian producers of steam coal with a total production of circa 8 mln tones and a sales agent for MIBRAG for the territory of CZ, SLK and HU
- EŽ CARGO is a newly established consulting structure that provides consultations and negotiations on rail transportation of various materials required by EP ENERGY group, but primarily coal and additives/sorbents. Territorial competence of EŽ Cargo covers primarily CZ, but also SLK and PL markets
- EOP HOKA is a energy side products handling subsidiary to EP ENERGY, providing services in storage and handling of energy side products (certified and non certified construction materials and waste), trading with certified construction materials as same as full scale truck logistics of these materials for the use of EP ENERGY and 3rd parties. EOP HOKA supplies special materials to the markets of CZ, D, HU and PL.
